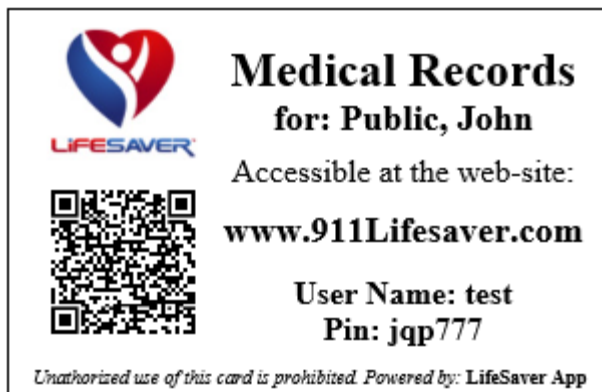

How It Works

When you purchase LifeSaver App™, you will be directed to a secure website to enter your medical records information. When you have finished entering your medications, allergies, conditions, surgeries, emergency contacts, insurance coverage and special need information, you can print an emergency identification card.

Put a copy in your wallet, a copy on your refrigerator, a copy in your glove box and any other place that emergency responders might look for medical information.



Immediate Access

Using your medical ID card, EMTs or emergency room doctors can access your emergency medical information over the Internet or via a Smart Phone using the QR code.

3. Hold your Smart Phone so that the 2-D barcode shows in the window. Your smart phone will load the demo medical report.
